The location of Naval Support Activity Annapolis in the sailing capital of the world makes for a fantastic place to take advantage of all the waters of the Chesapeake Bay have to offer. With two marina locations, Carr Creek Marina at the mouth of the Severn River and the CDR John L. Dunning Jr. Memorial Pier on Mill Creek, NSAA offers a wide variety of recreational boating options at affordable prices for eligible patrons. We offer all kinds of marina services at reasonable prices, and our knowledgeable, friendly staff are there to serve you.

Slips & Dry Storage

The CDR John L. Dunning Jr. Memorial Pier at Mill Creek (140 Hooper High Rd.) has 32 slips with water and electric hookups that accommodate boats up to 40-feet long. The slips are rented annually and contract applications are filed on a status group priority basis. Completed contracts may be e-mailed, faxed or mailed to the Carr Creek Marina.



We also have a dry storage facility (at Carr Creek location—338 Halligan Rd.) which can accommodate boats, RVs and pop-up campers. Haul-out, wash and launch are available by appointment Monday through Friday.

Mill Creek Pier is a designated clean marina partner. This recognition from the Maryland Department of Natural Resources acknowledges the marina staff's efforts focused on environmental protection and conscientiousness.



Rentals

Carr Creek Marina rents canoes, kayaks, JON boats with trolling motor (hourly or full day), Power boats (15 and 17 foot), Sailboats (22- and 24 foot) and Standup paddle boards (half day, full day, weekend or weekly). Safe boating certification is required for those renting boats if you were born after 1972.

Sailing Lessons

The Marina offers our Basic Keelboat/Skipper "B" sailing qualification classes. Classes start on Friday evenings from 6 p.m. until 9 p.m. with classroom time and then the students are out on the water on Saturday and Sunday from 8:30 a.m. until 4 p.m. Once the student passes the course, they are allowed to rent our 24-foot Rainbow sailboats. Classes are **\$275 (\$220 for active duty)** and run weekly as demand requires from Memorial Day through Labor Day Weekend.

In conjunction with this course, the student can earn their American Sailing Association (ASA) 101 Basic Keelboat Certification by taking and passing the ASA 101 test for **\$80**. This certification widely is accepted throughout the world. This certification will give the student the ability to use their qualifications worldwide and to build onto their ASA portfolio as their skills improve and they attend more challenging classes.

Maryland Safe Boater Course

Carr Creek Marina offers the Maryland Department of Natural Resources Police's Maryland Basic Boating Course. This \$25 course is a National Association of State Boating Law Administrators (NASBLA) approved course and meets the Maryland legal requirement for persons born after July 1972 to operate a powered vessel.

The course is offered one Saturday per month during the winter from 8a.m. to 5p.m. with an hour for lunch. This course is taught in the classroom and outside, so dress accordingly. Class reservations are now being taken for the entire winter. Advanced registration is required as there is a minimum class size. Please contact the Marina for cost and more details.
